### LONDON FINANCES

The changes to the way the London Church operates financially that were introduced on 1-Jun-10, as explained recently at our Financial Presentation, were done so with a commitment that they would be reviewed by the London Leadership Team (LLT) and London Advisory Group (LAG) in September. At our meeting on the 14th Sep we reviewed the London Church accounts, with a particular emphasis on the contribution as this had received much focus and attention over the summer. While there has been a small increase in the contribution, the overall financial picture has not yet materially improved from that which caused us to make the financial changes a few months ago. Consequently, the LLT and LAG have agreed to continue the current arrangements until at least the end of the year. The LLT and LAG have asked Paul Rowden and Andrew Agerbak (Northwest) to begin investigating alternative financial arrangements that could be implemented once the current phase has passed. ### BENEVOLENCE FUND

Benevolence needs within the congregation have until now been primarily dealt with by the Leadership Group, with any monetary assistance coming from Regular Contribution. With the progress made with the Gifts Ministries, and the setting up of a Benevolence Ministry, the Leadership Group would shortly like to delegate all benevolence needs to this ministry. To support this, we will be taking a collection on Oct 17th for a Benevolence Fund, where monies given are for the sole purpose of meeting benevolent needs. The Benevolence Ministry will administer this fund, under the oversight of the Leadership Group. We anticipate that further collections for the Benevolence Fund will be made a few times per year from now on.
