

## Western European Singles Conference 2016 ~ Question and Answer sheet

### WHO CAN ATTEND

**Is the conference open to singles outside Europe?** Absolutely! The more the merrier.

**Can my non-Christian friends come?** If your friend has been studying the bible and is close to making their decision then please encourage them to book.

### ACCOMMODATION

**Where can I stay?** We have arranged a special **room only rate** with two nearby Travelodge hotels for the nights of Friday 29<sup>th</sup> April & Saturday, 1<sup>st</sup> May. You must stay the two nights to have the special rate. They are [Travelodge Farringdon, WC1X 9QE](#) and [Travelodge London Central City Road, EC1Y 1AG](#). A web link and prices will be posted on Tuesday 1 March.

Travelodge Farringdon is £80.40 per room per night.

Travelodge Central City Road is £70.20 per room Friday night and £96.60 per room Saturday night.

The rooms are twin bedded or rooms with one double bed.

Breakfast is £7.95 per person.

You must book and pay for this yourself.

Other hotels and hostels nearby are on a separate list.

**Is there a discounted rate for additional nights at the Travelodges?** No, the special rate is for Friday 29<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> May ONLY. We do not have a discounted rate available for other nights around the conference dates.

**I'd love to come to the conference but my budget won't stretch to hostel or hotel costs; are there disciples nearby that I could stay with?**

Please note that as the conference is in Central London and most of us do not live in central London. You will have to factor in travelling time over the three days as well as the additional travel costs by train, bus or tube (underground trains).

### TRAVEL

**By Air** - There are several airports in and around London. The closest is City Airport. The main airports are Heathrow & Gatwick. The low cost airlines mainly fly in to Luton & Stansted.

**A useful local travel website – Transport for London** <https://tfl.gov.uk/> Route maps, plan your journey.

The underground train in London is known as the Tube.

**Will I be met at the airport or train station on arrival?** No unless you have made a private arrangement with a disciple you know in London. People are arriving at different times, on different days and in different ways so we are unable to do this.

### **How far is City Temple from tube (underground) stations?**

The closest tube station to the City Temple is **not** Holborn. The closest tube stations are:

- Chancery Lane (Central Line) exit 3. City Temple is about 3 minutes' walk east.
- Farringdon (Circle, District and Hammersmith & City Lines). City Temple is about 4 minutes' walk south west.
- St Paul's (also on the Central line). City Temple is about 5 minutes' walk west.
- Blackfriars (Circle and District Lines). City Temple is about 6 minutes' walk north.

### **How much will it cost to travel around London for the conference?**

The City Temple is close to St Paul's, Chancery Lane and Blackfriars tube stations.

The Institute of Education (Logan Hall) is close to Euston, Euston Square & Russell Square tube stations.

If you are staying at a hotel or hostel within Zone 1 you will only need a Zone 1 travel card (for use on buses and tube trains) for the duration of the conference. If you are staying elsewhere then please check.

### **MEALS**

**Are meals included over the weekend?** No. There are many places near each venue for you to hang out with each other and have a meal or refreshments. Snacks will be provided at the party on Saturday. This website is helpful.
